Good Afternoon,

This is Allison Hayes, Principal of Assumption College School. I'm reaching out with an important message.

This afternoon, the Brant County Health Unit confirmed two cases of COVID-19 in our school community. Understandably, for privacy reasons, the identity of these individuals will not be disclosed. These individuals have been directed by the health unit to self-isolate along with any family member residing at the same location.

At this time, the Brant County Public Health Unit has not identified any close contacts at our school to this COVID-19 case. If we receive additional information from the health unit that Assumption College School students or staff are impacted, we will let you know as soon as possible.

Our school remains open to all individuals, not asked by Public Health to self-isolate. Brant Haldimand Norfolk Catholic District School Board custodians continue to complete their disinfecting of our school throughout the day and each evening.
