



Family and Community Communication – Confirmed Case of COVID-19 in School Community

Good Afternoon Families,

This is Darren Duff, Principal of St. John's College. I am reaching out with an important message.

Today, the Brant County Health Unit confirmed a case of COVID-19 in our school community. Understandably, for privacy reasons, the identity of the individual will not be disclosed. They have been directed by the health unit to self-isolate.

At this time, the Brant County Public Health Unit has not identified any close contacts at our school to this COVID-19 case. If we receive additional information from the health unit that St. John's College students or staff are impacted, we will let you know as soon as possible.

St. John's College remains open and our custodians continue to complete their disinfecting of our school each night.

A friendly reminder that all St. John's College students and staff are required to monitor their health daily and pass the [COVID-19 School Screening](#) before entering our building. If students or staff develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19, they are required to contact their primary health care provider. Anyone concerned that they may have developed or been exposed to COVID-19 is encouraged to get tested.
